DPT Program Update

- DPT Director: Marc Campolo hired and started July 2020
- Program development underway focus on CAPTE requirements
- CAPTE visit June 2022
- Goals this year:
 - hire a director of clinical education
 - build out DPT space in DOW
 - begin marketing the program
- Working with the Foundation on ongoing fundraising campaign
- Matriculate first students summer 2023

New Programs

- Lake Washington Institute of Technology Mechanical Eng.
 - Proposal approved by both WSAC and NWCCU
 - Feasibility and costs discussion ongoing
- B.S. Data Science
 - NWCCU approved, begun this fall
- Doctor of Physical Therapy
- M.S. in Renewable Energy Engineering
 - begun this Fall at KF
- Air University Associate Baccalaureate Cooperative
 - BAS in Technology and Management



Potential New Programs

- Management department exploring M.S. Engineering Management and MBA Degrees
- M.S. in Manufacturing Engineering Technology to be reactivated – likely fall 2021
- Business Management and Healthcare Management degrees in PM – early notice at SPC, proposal to SPC next meeting
- BHS-MLS concurrent degree program at PM (new location)



Scheduling Improvements

- Two year schedule of courses posted on registrar's site
 - Programs can review frequency of offerings
 - Students can plan their terms, reduce need for trailer sections
- Cancellation of classes with low enrollment prior to start of classes, advising of students to other classes
- Compliance with HB2871 course material posting
- Lists of all non-registered returning students sent weekly to department for faculty advisors to contact – retention goal
- Embedded advising coordinators being hired for each college

Facilities

- Cornett Hall renovations completed
 - makerspace and lobby ready January '21
- CEET
 - now to include a chemistry lab* and undergraduate research lab spaces.
- Boivin renovation
 - relocation of all users for ~18 months, includes the ROCK, online education, IT, classrooms, faculty offices
 - Upgrades and reorganization of all spaces, chemistry lab rebuild

 - will have her project (device to detect and report small scale space junk) launched and in orbit the winter/spring.
- Dr. Scott Prahl will become chair of EERE Jan 2021
- Faculty involved in national society leadership
 - Sean St. Clair: American Society for Engineering Education Civil Engineering Awards Chair
- Applied research grants (industry)
 - Mustafa Saber has 2 additive manufacturing grants with OMIC
 - OREC, led by Mason Terry, continues to expand research in renewable energy





Health, Arts and Sciences update


- MariaLynn Kessler is new chair for Humanities and Social Sciences

 - Trevor Petersen and Maria Lynn Kessler co-directed Oregon Tech Relationship Building. Grant funded, student oriented project that benefits the Klamath Falls Community.
- Working with students on applied undergraduate research projects
 - Robyn Wilde's NSF physics grant is specifically designed for him to work with students.
- Being named to committees across the state, region and nation
 - Don McDonnell—Oregon Society of Radiologic Technologists—Chair of the Board. Served as president in 2019.
- Dealing admirably with the pandemic uncertainties, especially in the classroom
 - Many planned student events were cancelled this past year as a result of the pandemic, e.g.
 Dental Hygiene international service in Jamaica, conference presentations in PSY and COM.




