RECOGNITION 1 2 3 Based on the certification of the Employment Relations Board of the State of Oregon, Oregon Tech (the Employer) recognizes Oregon Tech American Association of University Professors (OT-AAUP 4 or the Association) as the exclusive representative of all members of the bargaining unit established 5 in the certification dated June 27, 2018 (Case No. RC-008-18), for the purpose of collective 6 bargaining as defined by law. 7 8 On June 27, 2018, the Employment Relations Board of the State of Oregon certified Oregon Tech American Association of University Professors (Oregon Tech AAUP or OT-AAUP) as the exclusive 9 bargaining representative of the following bargaining unit for the purpose of collective bargaining: 10 All faculty working at .5 FTE or above at Oregon Institute of Technology. 11 Excluded from the faculty bargaining unit are employees in the following groups: 12 1. Faculty employed as president, vice president, provost, vice provost, dean, associate 13 dean, assistant dean and interims, respectively; 14 15 2. faculty employed in an administrative position without reasonable expectation of teaching, research, or other scholarly accomplishments; 16 3. classified staff: 17 4. unclassified staff; 18 5. confidential employees; 19 6.1. department chairs. 20
