The provisions of Article 40, Section 8, of the SEIU Local 503, OPEU, Collective Bargaining Agreement, as of the date of this form, apply for the purpose of allowing employees to donate accrued vacation leaves for use by eligible recipients as sick leave. Oregon Tech will allow employees to make *irrevocable* donations of accumulated vacation to a coworker who is also party to the Bargaining Agreement. For purposes of this agreement, hardship leave donations will be administered under the following stipulations and the terms of the agreement shall be strictly enforced with no exceptions.

- The recipient and donor must be regular represented employees of Oregon Tech.
- The employer shall not assume any tax liabilities that would otherwise accrue to the employee.
- Employees otherwise eligible for or receiving workers' compensation, short or long-term disability, or on parental leave that does not qualify under Family Medical Leave Act and/or Oregon Family Leave Act will not be considered eligible to receive donations under this agreement.
- Should the donated leave not be exhausted for the purpose for which it was donated, the unused leave will be pooled for use by future recipients.
